These results show that there is a significant difference between the mean and median salary for males and females across Kingsbridge Educational Trust (KET) with males earning on average 23.21% more than females.

The data also shows that 75% of females' pay is in the lower quartile and 24% in the lower middle quartile, whereas for male staff, 49% are in the lower quartile and 44% are in the lower middle quartile.

However, the following should be considered:

80% of KET's workforce are female, and of those, 73% are part time varying from 7.5 hours to 37 hours per week and mostly term time only.
